Fiona has worked in the visual arts in Australia for over 20 years, in a variety of roles, for a number of key organisations and people.

Her expertise in coordinating and managing touring art exhibitions was honed at the Australian Exhibitions Touring Agency, an Australia Council initiative; the National Gallery of Australia; the Art Gallery of NSW, the Biennale of Sydney and the Regional Galleries Association of NSW.

Fiona has an in depth and current knowledge of the network of artists, commercial galleries, public galleries and museums (both large and small), and major art events across Australia, together with the industry of specialists which support them.

She has enjoyed the privilege of working with artists, curators, specialists, volunteers and gallerists to install major artworks outdoors, in galleries and museums, in abandoned warehouses and wharves, in luxury private homes and corporate offices.

Fiona has worked extensively as a volunteer and consultant in philanthropy and fund-raising, sourcing and securing funding for the purchase of artworks, realising art-related events and supporting individual artists and institutions.

She chaired the Committee of the Contemporary Collection Benefactors of AGNSW for 3 years and was a member of the Committee for 8 years.
